Minutes of Meeting

The Oklahoma State Board of Examiners of Perfusionists met on January 24, 2017, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The meeting was held at the office of the Board, 101 NE 51st Street, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma. Advance notice of this regular meeting was transmitted to the Oklahoma Secretary of State on November 1, 2016, and posted on the Board's website on January 20, 2017. Having noted a quorum, Mr. Miller called the meeting to order at 7:00p.m.

Following Board review, Mr. Hamilton moved to approve the minutes of the December 21, 2016 special meeting as written. Dr. Peyton seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

Next, **STEVEN HAWLEY** appeared in support of his application for renewal of Licensed Perfusionist licensure. Dr. Fisher stated that he does not have any doubt about Mr. Hawley's competency or ability but at the last meeting there was no evidence for them to review. Mr. Hawley provided two professional endorsements for the Board's review and stated that he felt as if some period of professional observation was reasonable. Mr. Miller stated he has worked with Mr. Hawley his entire career. He stated that Mr. Hawley has always been involved in the latest technology as well as serving as a mentor to perfusionists. Mr. Hawley confirmed that he is board certified and recently took the clinical exam and passed at a Master level. Dr. Peyton stated that his silence on the matter should not be construed as anything other than

support of Mr. Hawley. Following much Board discussion and based on the fact that applicant has been out of practice for approximately one year, Dr. Fisher moved to approve the application for full licensure of **STEVE HAWLEY** conditioned upon supervision by a licensed perfusionist for 12 cases, to be completed within six (6) months, with a satisfactorily written report received from Supervisor on Applicant's competency at the conclusion of those 12 cases. Mr. Hamilton seconded the motion and the vote was unanimous in the affirmative.

There being no further business, Mr. Hamilton moved to adjourn the meeting. The time was 7:33 p.m.
